Bringing business capital to Rochester's low income neighborhoods

If you have a small business in one of Rochester's low income neighborhoods, you now have another source of loan funding to help you grow your business. Due to our not-for-profit status, you may qualify for a loan that might not be available through more traditional commercial lending sources.

Loans Available

- Loan amounts from \$10,000 and up to \$50,000
- Repayment terms up to 5 years
- Interest is 5% per year

Assistance

- Assistance offered to prepare applications
- Business mentoring support may be offered or required for making a loan

Other Requirements

- You must have been in business for at least 1 year
- Your business must be located in one of Rochester's low income neighborhoods or invest in an operation located in a low income neighborhood
- Your investment must lead to the creation of at least one new job over three years
- You must demonstrate financial sustainability of the business and your ability to repay the loan
